#### What is the accompanied train ride?

Please note that this option has to be reserved 7 days in advance: in case of a late reservation, its price might be doubled.

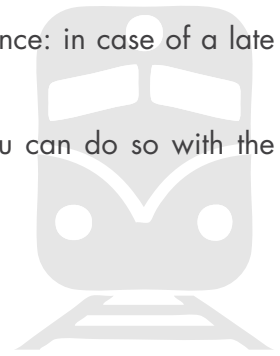

## Departure

For the departure from the camp you have different possibilities. As a general rule, however, most of the kids leave on Saturday after the excursion.

- On Friday after lunch at around 13.30
- In Camp on Saturday morning before the excursion at around 9am
- In Camp on Saturday afternoon after the excursion directly from the station of the excursion place between 3pm and 3.30pm

# Weekly Schedule

Arrival is always Sunday and departure is usually on Saturday after the excursion.

## On Sunday after your arrival

With the short oral and written test on Sunday evening, we'll find out which course you will be placed into and what level you are at the beginning of the week. In addition to the oral, the written test helps you and us to evaluate your language level. Then, together with our teachers, you can arrange individual and customised personal learning goals - please don't be afraid of the test! It helps you to get the best out of your language course!

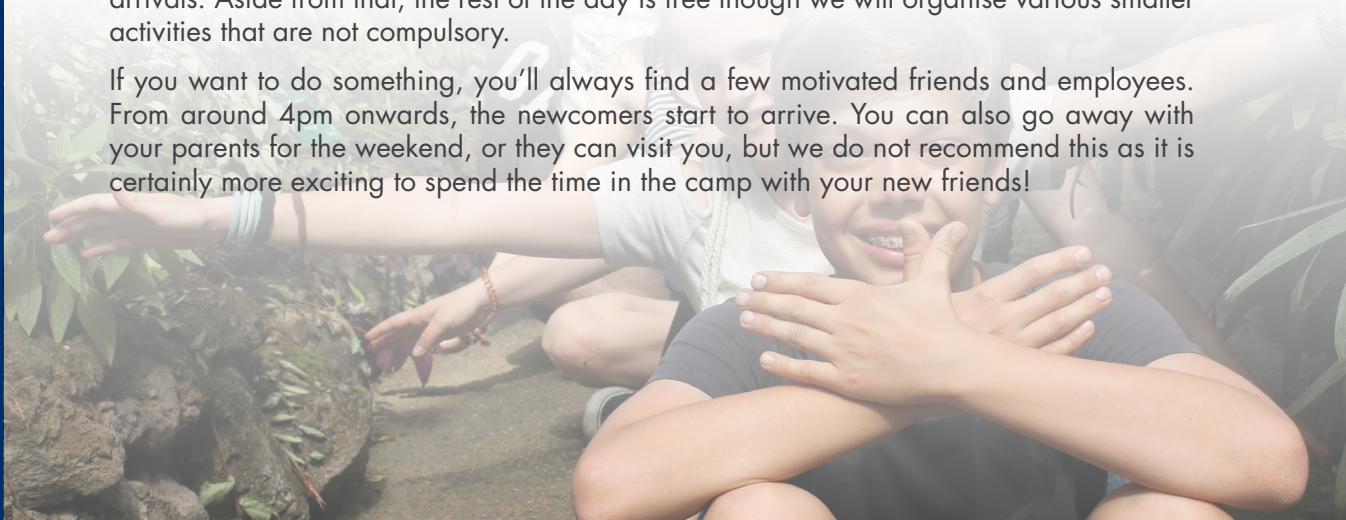
## Saturday

On Saturday, a full-day excursion takes place. We leave after breakfast to visit one of the sights or cities in the region and return to the camp in time for dinner. If you leave on Saturday, please see departure information on the previous page.

## Sunday

If you stay longer than a week at the camp, you can relax on Sunday. We start from 8:30 am with a nice breakfast. Afterwards we clean the rooms and common spaces for the new arrivals. Aside from that, the rest of the day is free though we will organise various smaller activities that are not compulsory.

If you want to do something, you'll always find a few motivated friends and employees. From around 4pm onwards, the newcomers start to arrive. You can also go away with your parents for the weekend, or they can visit you, but we do not recommend this as it is certainly more exciting to spend the time in the camp with your new friends!

## 1. Clothes and shoes

# Rules for participants

We will also go through this rule sheet verbally with the participants on the Sunday evening after dinner. We want to spend a great time together and if we all stick to these rules then a fun and relaxing camp experience is guaranteed for all!

## Property / Beach / Lake

- o No one is allowed to leave the area alone.
- o Nobody is allowed to go to the lake/ beach.
- o Swimming is permitted only with the supervision of the teachers / supervisors.

We offer the option of a one **free afternoon** per week because we believe that everyone needs a bit of alone time at some point. Children older than 12 years are allowed to leave the camp during the free afternoon under the following conditions:

- o They stay in groups of 2 or more people.
- o No swimming.
- o Mobile phone must be taken with you.
- o The children must be adhere to the agreed rules and return at the agreed time.

Anyone who breaks the rules during the week may have their free afternoon taken away from them. We do also offer other activities such as swimming, football or a film, so the free afternoon is not obligatory.

## Mobile Phones

Mobile phones are prohibited during the night, during classes and during meal times. For minor offenses our employees have the right to confiscate phones for a certain period of time.

## Showers / WC

The showers and toilets are shared and not just for your own use so please remember to respect others and save water where possible.

## In the rooms

Fire of all types is absolutely prohibited! No candles, incense sticks or similar items. We do not want any graffiti on the walls or any hotel property broken. You should not eat inside the rooms, however a bottle of water next to your bed is OK.

Please try to keep order and consider and respect those who want to sleep!

## Property / valuables

Please respect property that doesn't belong to you! Please be careful with the material of friLingue, your fellow participants and do not take anything that doesn't belong to you without asking.

**Important:** You can keep your valuables (keys, money bags, Watches, jewelry, etc.) in the safe or give them to the campleader for safekeeping.

## Meals

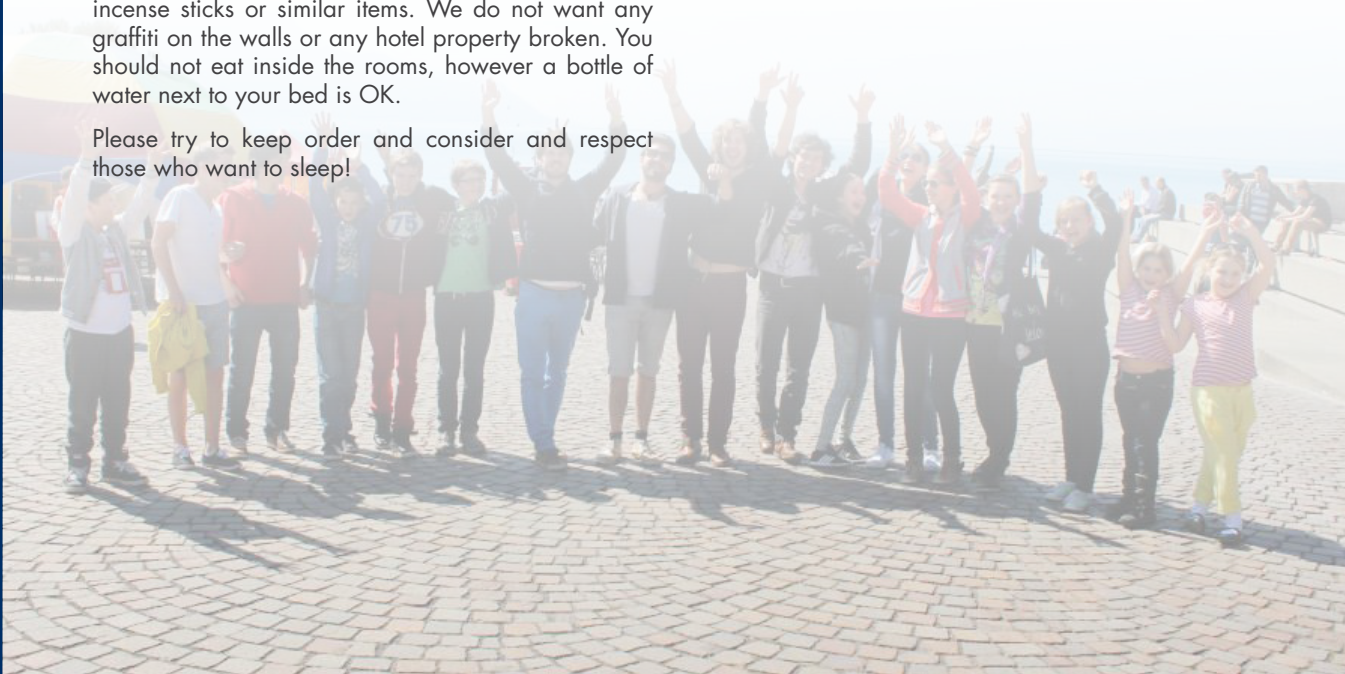

If you finish before the others, please sit still at the table as we like to start and finish together. Once you're finished eating please put your dirty plates and cutlery in the washbasins provided.

## Smoking & Alcohol

**With friLingue there is no smoking and there is strict alcohol & drugs ban. Anyone caught breaking this rule will be sent home immediately. This is also applicable to students over the age of 16.**

That may sound like a lot of rules but most of them are rules that you follow in your own house and in your daily life. We are sure that we will have a good time together and we don't want to act or be seen as teachers and figures of authority, but rather more as friends. However, that means that we expect from you a lot: punctuality, respect and responsibility among other things - just as you'd expect from your real friends.

We want to communicate clear rules for the camps right from the start. We kindly ask you to read over the contract with your son or daughter and make sure that it's understood. friLingue camps only work when our ground rules are adhered to.

1.1. I have read and understood the enclosed rules.

1.2. I agree that during the camp no alcohol or drugs may be consumed. Anyone caught with alcohol or intoxicants of any kind will be sent home immediately. In this case, the camp costs will not be reimbursed.

1.3. I agree that the bedtime curfew of 10pm must be strictly observed. Anyone who breaks this rule for the first time will be issued with an official warning, a second breach will result in that person being sent home. The camp costs will also not be refunded in this case.

1.4. We agree that the participants must follow the instructions given by the animators, especially those regarding the security. friLingue could not be held responsible in case these instructions would not be respected.

1.5 We are aware that the medical insurance is the responsibility of the participants.

1.6 Participants will be entitled to use their cell phones and other electronic devices one hour after lunch and one hour after dinner. The rest of the time, all their devices will be kept by the camp leader.

1.7. Participants are encouraged to take care of their personal belongings. friLingue can not be held responsible in case an item is lost by or stolen from a participant. In the event of property damage, the costs will be borne by the participant.
